

## Emergency relief implementation to three thousand displaced family in Karbala'a governorate

IAA ended the emergency relief implementation of 3000 displaced and continent families hosted in Kerbala' governorate. Those families are distributed over 61 districts in the center and some other regions of Kerbala'. The relief included 31 items of nurture and other supplies to fulfill their basic needs. The programme was supported by the International immigration organization in coordination with the following bodies in Kerbala':

- Immigration department.
- Governorate's council.
- Local municipalities.
- Chief of Districts' covered by the programme.

Governor of Kerbala', municipalities' chairmen and members, and representatives of the Ministry of Migration and Displaced, have attended few activities of the programme.



This humanitarian initiative took place to reduce the severe sufferings of the displaced families, living under worst circumstances in housing , with almost no access to education and health care, lack

of drinking water, electric power and fuel, sewage and jobs. Moreover they are traumatized by loosing their provider, home or any of the family members by assassinations or kidnapping in their previous livelihoods. They are also living under continuous fear for loosing security, humiliating feeling of dignity and rights violation in addition to their fear of loosing their own homes and possessions.

**The support of the government, international organizations and UN to those families is a must to enable the government departments and civil society people to ensure the essential needs for them.**

**IAA calls upon political leaderships and decision makers to provide services and security to facilitate the return of displaced families to their original residences, and**

**and compensate their loss and damages, cure their psychological shocks. IAA called to consider the aforementioned appeals as main steps to the national reconciliation and retain rule of law and justice for all people.**
