

Aid distribution for displaced families in Nynwa plain region/Al-Mousl governorate

Iraqi Al-amal association started in collaboration with the support of Etana women gathering in Nynwa plain region in Al-mousl governorate and the international Red Cross organization an aid distribution process during may 2008, the project lasted from 11 till 16-4-2008, targeting 250 Iraqi families, the beneficiaries were selected from IDPs, displaced inside Iraq, poor families, widows, orphans, and violence victims, children and women were the largest percentage of beneficiaries from the project, most families are Iraqi Christians who had been displaced from governorates of Al-Mousl, Baghdad, Al-Anbar, Al-Bsra and Slah al-deen

The distribution process took place according to the following:

- 1-Bakofa for 9 families and Mar oraha for 21 families and Batnaya for 50 families villages in 11-4-2008.
- 2-Telkeef region in 13-4-2008 for 50 families.
- 3-Telaskof region in 16-4-2008 for 120 families.



The distribution took place through coordination between Iraqi team in field in Nynawa plain and Red cross office in Iraq north ,the field team worked under supervision of Ms. Janet S.Bejamin from Etana women gathering ,the distribution was very easy, organized and witnessed a high attendance from IDPs families ,who expressed their gratitude to such projects and asked for larger amounts of aids in future to cover the needs of all IDPs families in the area ,and hoped such projects will increase in future to ease their sufferings.
