

Graduation of Conflict Resolution three (CR3) Teenage Students



In July 7th 2007, Iraqi AlAmal Association, celebrated the graduation of Class three of the Conflict Resolution amongst teenage students, for the year July '06-July '07, aiming to build capacity of the students, training them on team work, conflict resolution through dialogue, human rights and democracy education, and providing them with computers and English language skills,

The graduation event was attended by nearly 150 guests from: Ministries of Youth, Human rights, and Education,

representatives of the Integrity commission, Kerrada city council, media, parents, students from CR1 and CR2,

48 graduates participated in the event, presenting several activities: poem recital, singing, theatrical scenes, all of which was written, designed and acted by the graduate students, in addition to presenting the projects implemented by students (i.e. what people do not know about the poor and needy, violence against women, building self esteem, and keep clean campaign in schools)



With cheering audience, certificates were handed to the 48 graduate students,
